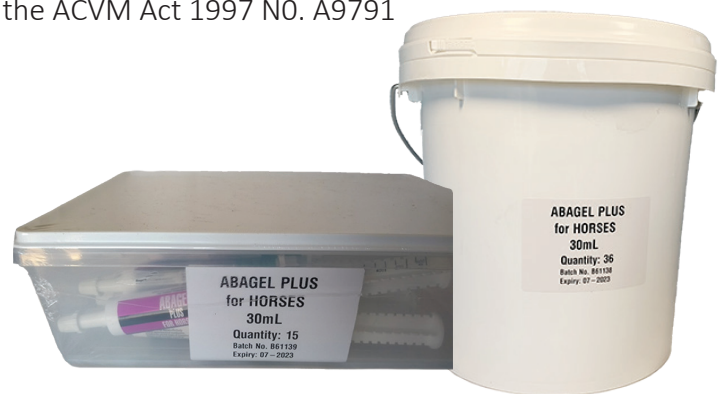


Abagel

Name:	Abagel Horse Wormer
Category:	Equine worm including sensitive strains of tapeworm and bot control.
Pack Sizes/Codes:	30g Syringe (TDCABA1). 15 x 30g. 36 x 30g
Use:	General purpose equine wormer. Effectively control gastrointestinal roundworms, including the arterial stages of strongylus vulgaris, small strongyles, lungworm and bots. Effective against benzimidazole resistant strains. Efficacy demonstrated against tapeworm.
Status:	Vet OTC
Ingredients:	4mg/ML Abamectin and 50mg/ml Praziquantel in a gel formulation.
Indications:	Effectively controls gastrointestinal roundworms, including the arterial stages of Strongylus vulgaris, small strongyles (including benzimidazole resistant strains), lungworm, bots and tapeworms in horses.
Action:	Praziquantel inhibits cestode carbohydrate metabolism.
Administration:	30g syringe will treat up to 100kg horse (one syringe division per 100kg).
Dosage:	Abagel should be used every 6-8 weeks.
Special Precautions:	For use in horses only.
Storage:	Store below 25°C
